

SKITTLE SCIENCE

WHAT YOU WILL NEED

Skittles

About 1/3 cup of warm water

White plate

Pencil/Crayons



THE ACTIVITY

First, arrange the Skittles around the inside edge of your plate. You can arrange them any way you want! We suggest a rainbow pattern for the best result. Make sure that you are doing this experiment on a flat and sturdy surface. If it wobbles or is at an angle the colors will mix too early.

Before you add the water, make a prediction about what you think will happen when warm water is added to the plate. Then write down your prediction on the recording sheet.

Now it is time to add the water! Add it slowly, so that you don't wash the Skittles around. In seconds, the beautiful colors will start showing!
